- Palfrey
- Pleck
- St Matthew's

Covers 17.5 sq km


Makes up 17% of borough area Population density of 35 people per hectare (higher than borough average of 26)

#### A Map of Facilities in South Locality








### **Population Structure**

#### Total population: 61,000

- Significantly younger age profile than borough overall
- Very high proportion of children and young working age
- Far fewer older people over 45



- 55.5% minority ethnic residents is well over double the borough average (24.1%)
- Asians comprise the largest minority group at 42.2% (Walsall 15.2%)
- All ethnic groups above Walsall average except White British






#### Households

- 22,000 occupied households
- Similar proportion of socially rented properties to Walsall average (24.2% and 24.1%)
- Much greater proportion of privately rented properties (17.3% compared with Walsall's 11.7%)
- Above average proportion of people under 65 living alone (19.7% compared with Walsall's 15.7%)





#### **Unemployment & Benefits**



Others on income related benefit

- 5,505 working age adults are dependent on an out-ofwork benefit
- Similar to borough but above national levels
- Numbers of jobseekers has reduced in recent years (but still above average)
- But a high proportion (3,045 residents) claim an ill-health related benefit and are unfit to work







### Skills and Qualifications

- Adult basic skills in literacy, numeracy and ICT skills similar to Walsall but below national average.
- Over 1 in 5 working age residents have no formal qualifications but this is better than Walsall average
- Those with degree level qualifications is also higher than borough average







- Broad east/west split in levels of deprivation.
- Areas close to the Town Centre, Caldmore and Pleck experience very high levels of deprivation.
- Some neighbourhoods in Gillity and Park Hall are among least deprived quarter in England.












#### **Total Recorded Crime**




 There were 4,985 crimes recorded in South during 2017.





- 3 of the 4 wards within the south locality are above the borough average





# Teen Conception Rates per 1,000 15-17 year olds

| Ward         | Rate |
|--------------|------|
| Paddock      | 16.8 |
| Palfrey      | 20.9 |
| Pleck        | 42.2 |
| St. Matthews | 45.6 |
| WALSALL      | 40.3 |

- Teen Conception rates for this locality vary by ward – Pleck & St. Matthew's are both above the borough average of 40.3.
- In contrast, Palfrey & Pleck are considerably lower than the borough average.








#### **Adult Obesity Prevalence**

Adult obesity levels are low within the South locality – all ward prevalence are below the borough average





#### Health Check Received - 40 to 74 Year Olds




Within the South locality, the number of NHS health checks received is average: WS1 = 837 WS2 = 1,098 (part of) WS5 = 487 (part of)




The highest proportion of Walsall residents providing unpaid care within the South locality is within the ward of Paddock

The highest prevalence rate for Coronary Heart Disease within the South locality is within St Matthew's.

St Matthew's prevalence is also slightly above the borough average.






Cancer prevalence within the wards of the South locality is lower than the borough average.

Diabetes prevalence within the wards of the South locality is greater than the borough average.




